Many programs are featured in this unique itinerary such as challenge events at Urraca, rock climbing, environmental awareness, mountain livin', black powder rifle, Rocky Mountain Fur Company, and .30/06 rifle shooting. You will tour and stay overnight at the famous Hunting Lodge. Take a ride, brand your boots and enjoy a chuck wagon dinner at Clarks Fork before spending your last night at Tooth Ridge trail camp. Hike into Base Camp over the famous Tooth of Time.
